"He remembered once when a committee of a Lodge in Charleston in which his subscriptions at the death of a fellow craft had left his family in destitution, was notified the Master of the Lodge desired to see John Henry Buist to ask for help. Mr. Buist asked how much was expected to be raised. When the reply \$500 was made, he still never forgot his words: 'Do not look for it, amount there is \$100. Do not say anything about it, the money is a matter open to the lodge in regular concert that contains the body of one who, exceptionally in this world of ours, had a soul!'"

On 29 December 1865 South Carolina did what no other state did not has done since, seceded from the Union. This began the road to the eventual war between the North and the South. In the months later sometime in March of 1861, George Lamb Buist volunteered as a Private in the Palmetto Guard Artillery, Company F, 2nd South Carolina Regiment. He left home for wife and children and did thereby answer to the call of duty to his home state of South Carolina and to the Confederate States of America.

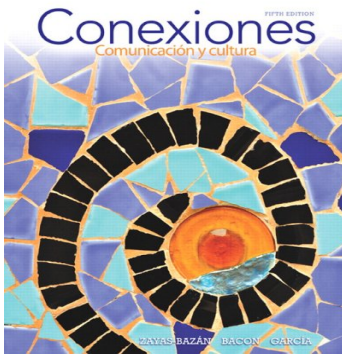
The medical establishments within the Confederate Army were almost unprepared for either the scope or duration of the conflict, which became known as the Civil War, or as the subject of this article would have called it, The War between the States. Regulations authorized each regiment of the Confederate Army a surgeon, an assistant surgeon, a hospital steward and several enlisted men serving as orderlies. During a battle the medical team set up a field hospital in the fighting line between 100 and 200 yds from the front of an attacking line. Surgeons and Assistant Surgeons like Dr. John Somers Buist would see the effects of the battlefield up close and personal and usually were concerned with any possible need for amputation, which happened and almost always were rare. Common wounds were said to be of the extremities such as the arm and leg. Dr. Buist would perform amputations to clear involving the preservation of a limb. Compound fractures, or in most cases infections such as gangrene. This was the daily routine of Dr. John S. Buist.

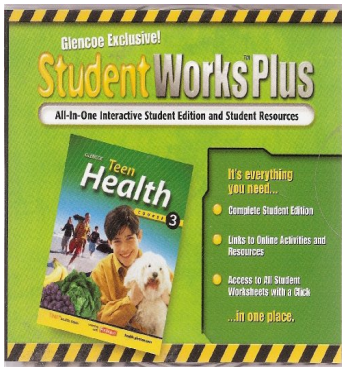

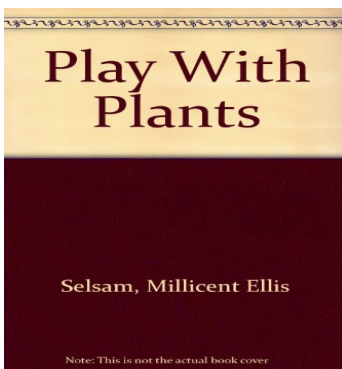
